Human trafficking, the U.N. calls it a modern form of slavery. It's not something we associate with life here Representative Ed Royce of in the United States. And while more than half of trafficking victims are in Asia and the Pacific, it is happening in this country too ... the U.S. is home to roughly 60,000 people who live in slave-like conditions.

It's an issue that's come to the attention of Republican California, the chairman of the House Committee on Foreign Affairs. Royce recently introduced legislation aimed at combating international human trafficking.

Combating Human Trafficking



Thanks to Rep. Ed Royce's leadership, his committee passed three bills to combat human trafficking:

Human Trafficking Prioritization Act prioritizes the fight against human trafficking without increasing the size of the Federal Government. "Women and children being bought and sold is deplorable, and shockingly this criminal trade is happening around the world and right here in Southern California."

International Megan's Law to Prevent Demand for Child Sex Trafficking to protect children from sex trafficking by providing foreign governments with advance notice of intended travel by registered child-sex offenders.

Human Trafficking Prevention Act requires State Department personnel undergo training to identify victims of human trafficking around the world.

Protecting Women from Becoming the Victims of Crime

Kathleen Gallagher Baty Author, Stalking Victim, & Crime Victim Advocate Ed Royce sponsored the nation's very first anti-stalking law, which was copied in all 50 states. He also wrote the Interstate Stalking Punishment and Prevention Act, which makes it a felony to stalk someone across state lines.

Royce wrote California's Proposition

115, the Crime Victims Speedy Trial Initiative, which established rights for crime victims in the state constitution.
