An American Dream

As a young girl, Janet Nguyen experienced the horrors of communism. Janet's father and uncle were both proud members of the South Vietnamese military. After the fall of Saigon, Janet's uncle was executed by the new government, and her family was slated to be put into a communist "re-education" camp. Instead they fled, first to a small village and from there they made several unsuccessful attempts to escape. Finally, after several attempts, Janet, her sister and mother were able to escape on a small wooden boat and eventually found the rest of their family in a refugee camp in Thailand.

Through the charity of a southern California church, Janet's family was sponsored to come to America. As immigrants they spoke no English and had to accept public assistance in order to survive. But they made it.

Through all these trials, Janet Nguyen never gave up on the American Dream. This is her story, in her own words. The story of a young girl's journey from a small village in Vietnam, to a refugee camp in Thailand, to Orange County, California and a campaign that many consider the most important state legislative contest in the country in 2014.
